Welcome to the Kansas TBF Youth & High School qualifying tournament. This is a joint tournament for Youth under 16 and those in High School.

Please make sure you have a state park pass, a fishing license (if 16 or older) and a KS Bass Pass which allows you to weigh in fish at least 15”.

We would like to thank the anglers for fishing with us, the boat captains & parents for their support and help.

TBF Kansas will follow the guidelines provided by the state of Kansas and the national TBF. We recommend all participants use masks and gloves when possible, but especially during check in, weigh in and awards. Social distancing must also be followed.

It is each angler and boat captain’s responsibility to review and understand the rules **provided below**. **Each angler and boat captain MUST respond to the Tournament Director by email or text that they have read and will comply with the rules.** Failure to do so may prevent you from participating in the tournament.

If there are any changes to the state of Kansas or KDWPT guidance that can affect our tournament, we will let you know immediately.

#### **Take Off & Launch:**

- **There is no pre-tournament meeting.**
- We launch and weigh-in at the Eisenhower State Park East boat ramp, Saturday, May 30<sup>th</sup> 2020.
- Once you have the boat ready, go to the ramp.
- Let the volunteer at the ramp know you are fishing the TBFKS.

- That volunteer will do a livewell check and give you your take off position as you launch your boat.
- If you need a weigh in bag, we will provide it at that time.
- Everyone on the water & ready to go by 6:00 AM.
- As your number is called please raise your hand and fall into line.
- Everyone in a single file line until you are outside the no wake area and the boat in front of you is on pad.
- When you come by the boat dock area have life jackets on, buckled & zipped, kill switch fastened, lights on until you reach your first stop.

### Check In:

- Youth teams will check in NLT 1:30 PM.
- High School teams will check in NLT 2:00 PM.
- Trailer your boat with fish in the livewells, aerators on manual.
- Check in location will be by the TBF posters, west side of the parking lot (see the map – blue star.).
- Remain in the boat/vehicle and let the volunteer know your boat number/names.
- Proceed around the loop to the weigh in location.
- You must check in whether you have fish or not. If you leave early you must call me. This is the only way to ensure all teams are safely off the water.

### Weigh in Procedure:

- Approach the weigh in site as shown on the attached map.
- Put your fish in the weigh in bag.
- Form a line and wait your turn.
- Remain in the boat or vehicle and hand the fish to the volunteer.
- We will take them from you, measure & weigh them and return them to you to put back in the lake off the dock. Do not release the fish from the bank.
- Once we have weighed your fish, we will give you a weigh ticket.
- Park & take your pictures away from the weigh in site.
- You can return to the weigh in area but **maintain social distances**.

Once all boats have checked in and all fish weighed, there will be an awards ceremony.
